    - e. Supporter agreement Form D15
    - f. Updated Mining work program Form C14
    - g. Copies of identification/registration documents of the person or entity applying
    - h. Copy of current artisanal mining licence
- 3. The application package must be submitted to the Regional Office of the Ministry of Mineral Resources to which the application relates
- 4. The applicant must check on the application 14 days from date of submission
- 5. The applicant must be aware that if the application is successful, they will be required to pay an annual charge and a contribution to the Rehabilitation Fund (as per Table A2 of the First Schedule) before the licence is issued
